- 2. Should have an experience of minimum 3 years in cooking/helping in cooking for preparation of Indian and continental meals befitting the status of VIPs/VVIPs in Guest Houses of Govt. Institution/Organizations.
- 3. Age 18 to 37 years (relaxation in age as per reservation rules of Punjab Govt.)

- **Note:** i). The pay of the incumbent shall be regulated in the terms of Punjab Govt. Circular no. 7/204/2012-4 FP.1/66 dated 15.1.2015.
 - ii). As per decision of Board of Management vide notification No.14353 dated 30.10.2018 the relaxation in age will be up to 45 years for the employees who have been engaged in University on contract basis for applying to the non-teaching posts (as per notification No.GSR.33/Const./ART 309/94 dated 4.5.1994 by the Punjab Govt.). The relaxation in age will be equivalent to period for which the employee has served PAU/Govt. organizations/Boards/Corporations on contract basis.
